


ādau janmāngato vipra ris	 akasya phalaṁ vadet 1 Riṣṭa causing tear, breaking, injury, hurt, miscarriage; symbolised by the weapons of the digpāla devatā; the power to punish, maim, torture; bad luck, bad omen, misfortune, calamity Ariṣṭa prefix 'a' is reversal of riṣṭa armour, proof against injury or damage, secure, safe; warning against misfortune like birds of ill omen who forewarn against impending dangers – heron (Sun), stork (Mars), crow (Saturn);




चतुर्विंशतिवर्षाणि यावद् गच्छन्ति जन्मतः। जन्मारिष्टं तु तावत् स्यादायुर्दायुं न चिन्तयेत् ॥ २॥ caturvimsativarṣāṇi yāvad gacchanti janmataḥ | janmāriṣṭaṁ tu tāvat syādāyurdāyuṁ na cintayet || 2||

Longevity of a chart should not be even thought about (predicted) till the 24th year is completed which is the janma-riṣṭa period

- 1. 24 syllables in gāyatrī
- 2. Bala-rista \rightarrow 12 Years
- 3. Yoga-riṣṭa → 20 Years
- 4. Janma-riṣṭa → 24 Years
- 5. Periods of ill health and such misfortunes can be stated as being 'evil' or 'dangerous' but never 'death'
- 6. To predict longevity i.e. death brings in gāyatrī doṣa and removal of sin ब्रहम शाप मोचन (brahma śāpa mocana), is necessary.








Durmantra


- If the 5th bhāva has the conjunctions of Saturn, Mars, Sun and Moon, the mother and brother are to die in quick succession
- 1. Moon conjoined all three malefic planets Mars, Sun and Saturn is in a very evil (angry) position
- 2. Moon affliction threatens mother while Saturn affliction threatens brother (elder)
- 3. The mantra bhāva comes under a curse called 'durmantra' which is to take effect shortly







- Rāhu in Cancer or Leo conjoined the luminaries (Sun and Moon)
- And Saturn, Mars aspect (or conjoin) Lagna
- Baby does not survive a week
- 1. Rāhu with the Sun and Moon is akin to a solar eclipse, and that too in Cancer or Leo damages the heart and lungs (Cn) or liver and stomach (Le)
- 2. Saturn and Mars aspecting the Lagna complete the negative association of all four malefic planets
- 3. Two malefic Rāhu + Sun hit Moon while Saturn and Mars attack Lagna ...baby goes down battling for life







































- A. Kṣīṇa (Low Light) Chandra
- B. Placed in Lagna, 7th, 8th or 12th bhāva
- C. Pāpa graha on either side of Chandra [Pāpa Kartari]
- Without doubt the native has automatic death which is quite early
- 1. Kṣīṇa Chandra is normally accepted as
 - 1. Kṛṣṇa Ekādaśī [K11] to Śukla Pañcamī [S5]
 - 2. Others prefer Kṛṣṇa Aṣṭamī [K8] to Śukla Aṣṭamī [S8]
- 2. The Lord of the tithī is the harbinger of evil if it is inimical to the dominating planet in lagna
