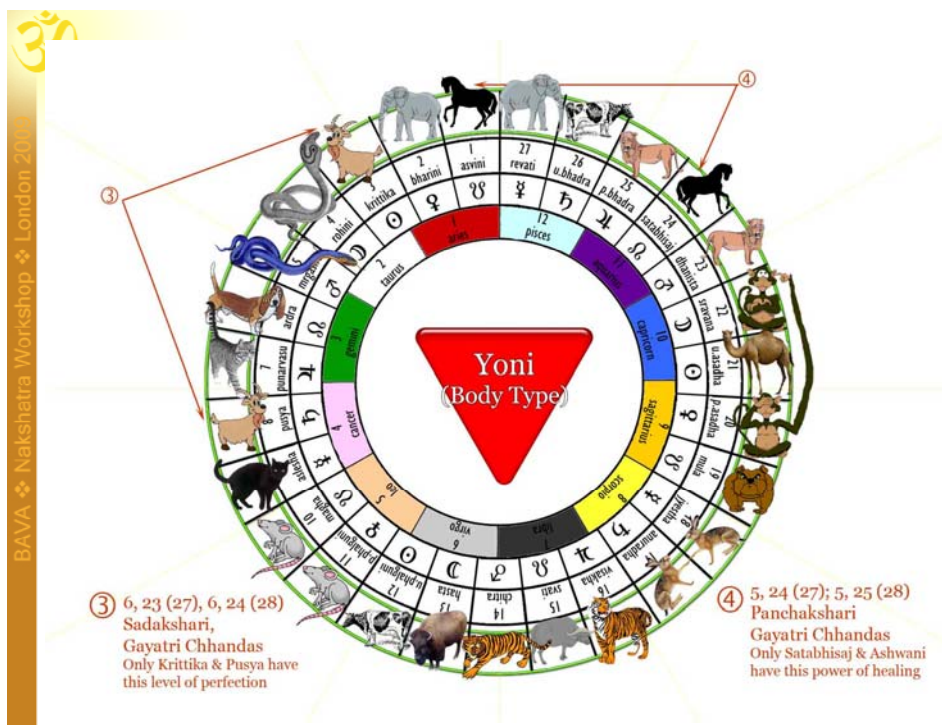
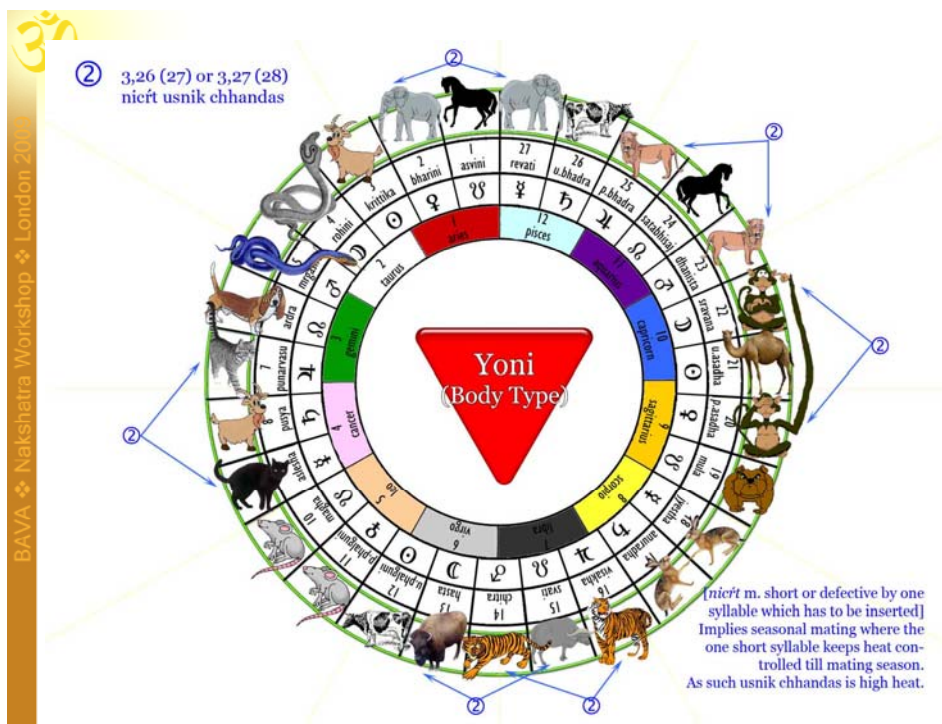
**YONI (BODY TYPE)**

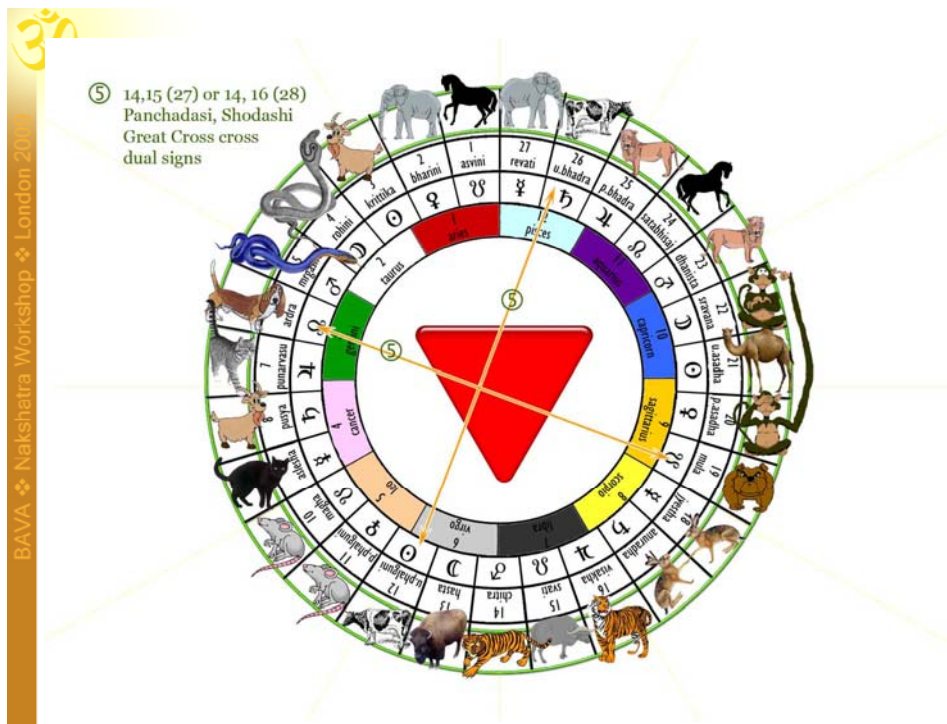
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# Yoni

1. Yoni literally means female sexual organ
  - Yet in all jyotish texts this has been used to mean ‘body type’ based on the female sexual organ that delivers the animal
  - Eg. Manushya Yoni, (human female organ that deliver a human baby etc.
2. Yoni is the symbol of the SECOND Nakshatra Bharani that maps to the 7<sup>th</sup> sign (opposite) Libra
  - Try to map the yoni types and the animal signs
  - Understand the yoni type and body heat cycle
  - All creation must be in a chhandas; Yoni map to chhandas

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## Shunya Definition

- Shunya literally means empty or void
- Refers to the void which exists between the material worlds (tri-loka: bhu, bhua, svarga) and the spiritual worlds (catur-loka: mahar, janar, tapar, satya)
- Akin to an eclipse point where the Sun shines but does not throw images.
- Dakshinamurti Samhita: Like the Sun in the grasp of Rahu, in that moment the doors of heaven open



## Two Types of Shunya

1. Masa Shunya = Certain Nakshatra are Shunya for each Sun sign
  - The reason can be positive like a chosen spiritual path or
  - negative like destruction of material objects, poverty, ill-repute
  - Seen from shunya nakshatra and planets associated
2. Tara Shunya = The converse of above i.e. Shunya in some signs due to the Janma Nakshatra
  - Reason is generally people related which is seen from Shunya rashi
  - Great depression leads to resignation or renunciation
  - Guru brings the mind to calm and become detached

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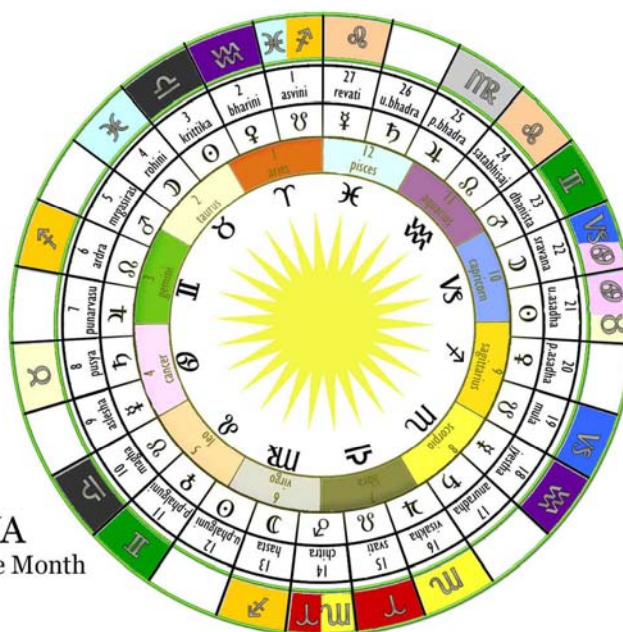

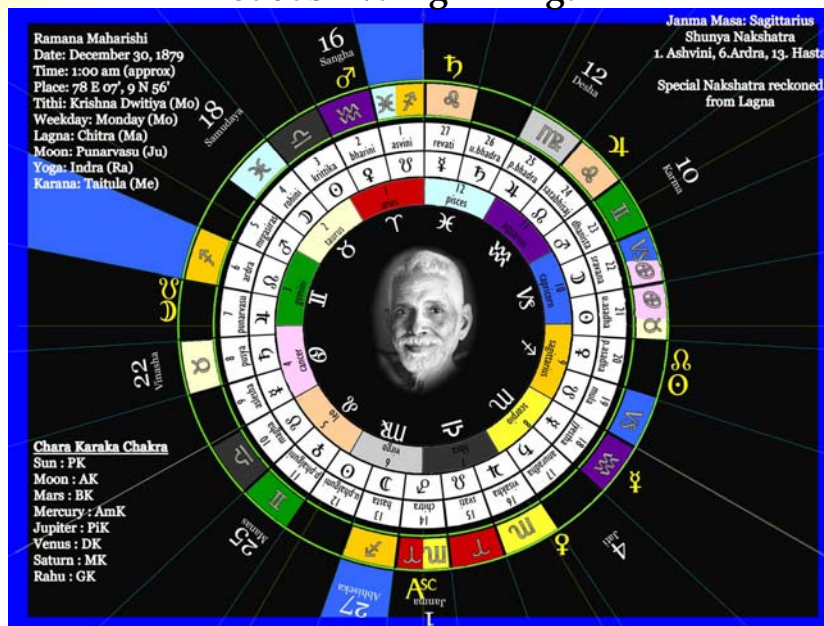
## Some Observations

- Abhisheka (27) in Shunya – Sadashiva (Linga)
- Vainasika (22) in Shunya – Kalika (Mahavidya) or Vishnu Avatara
- Janma/Lagna (1) in Shunya – Advaita (Shankara) Shiva
- Samudayika (18) in Shunya – Veda Murti, Gyana Yoga
  - Titles - Samudaya tara (18) from Moon
- Sangha (16) in Shunya – Brahmacharya
  - Mars in Sanghatika (16) indicates Brahmacharya

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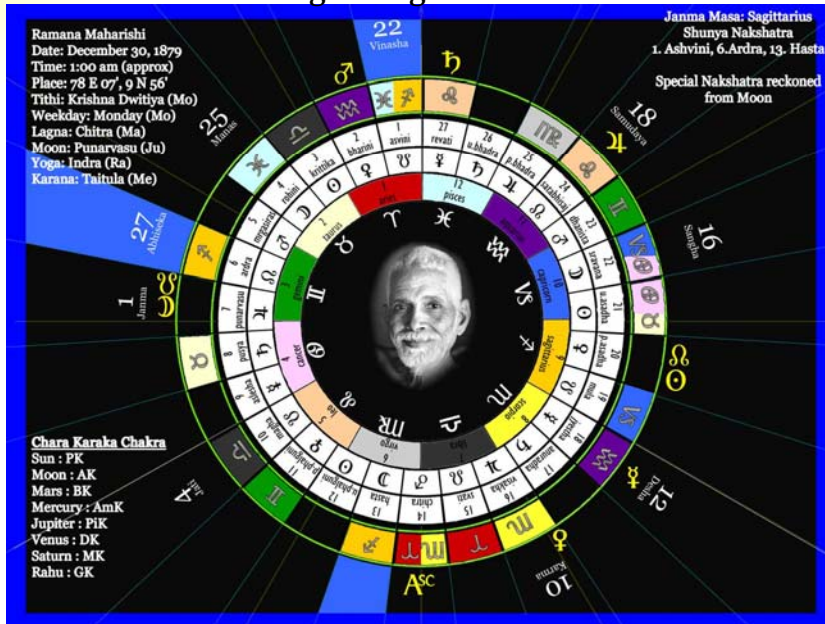


## Lagna Tara: Shunya Abhisheka Sadashiva Agni Lingam

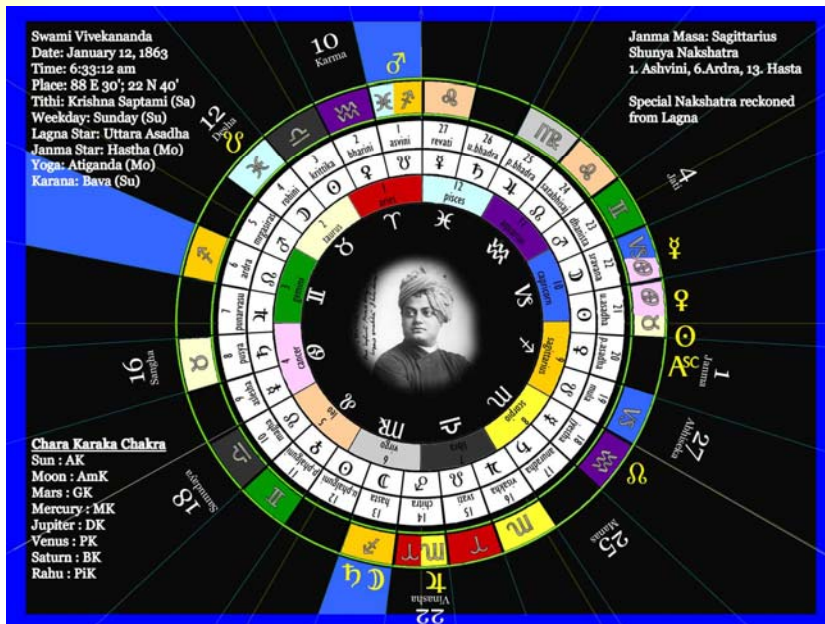


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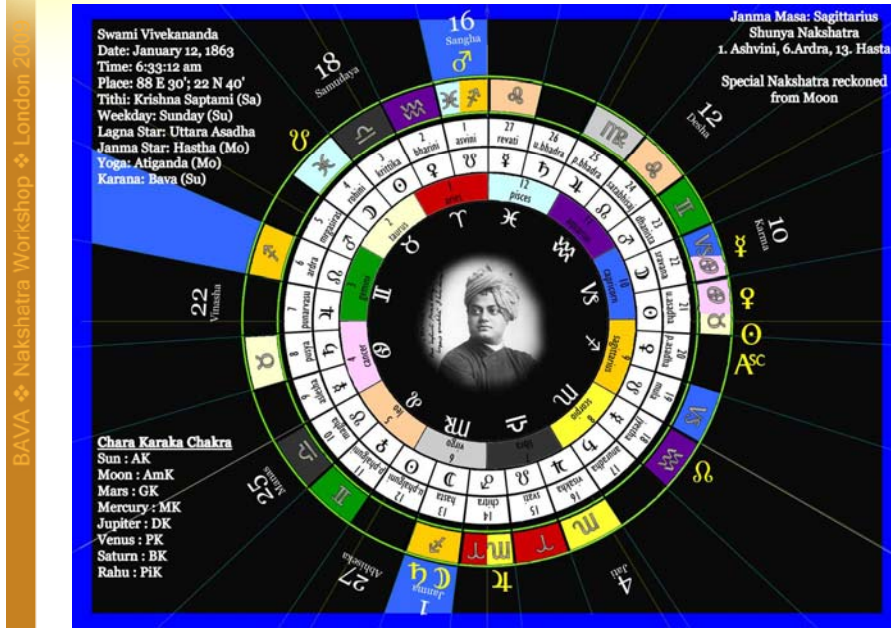
30 Moon Tara: Shunya Abhisheka 27 & Vainasika 22  
Sadashiva Agni Lingam at Arunachalam



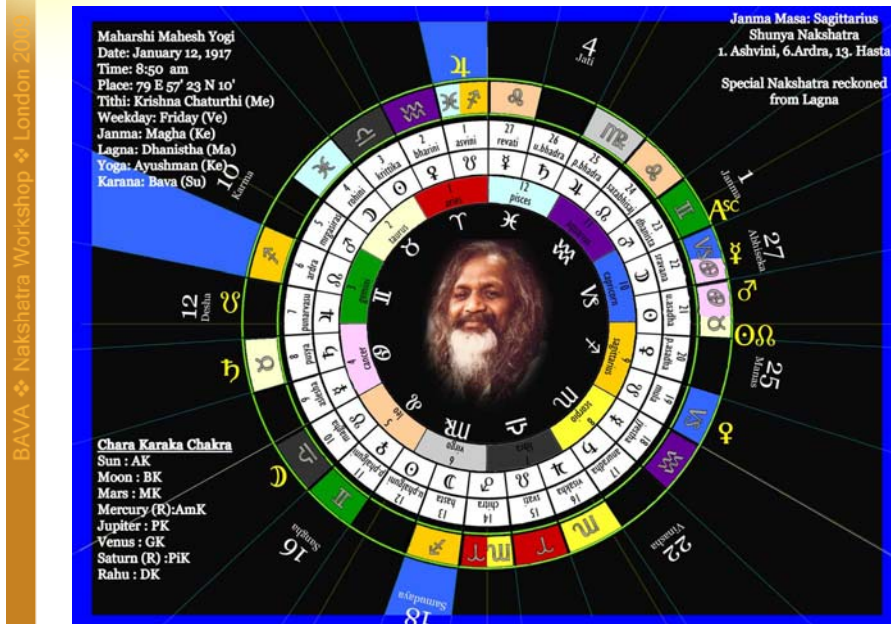
30 Lagna Tara: Ma, Sa, Mo Shunya



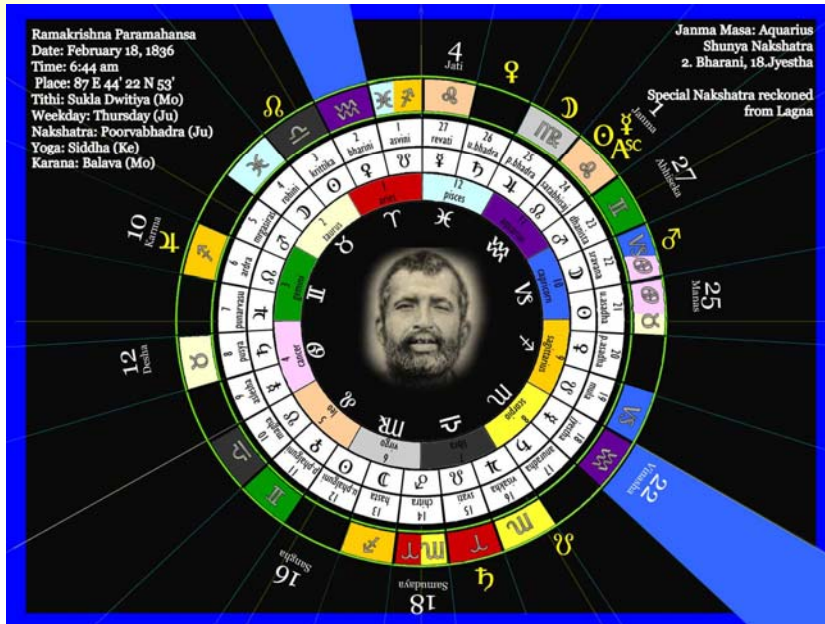
### 30 Moon Tara: Janma (1) Sangha, Ma (16) Shunya
